The project is about to come to an end, following two years of hard work, meetings, and a final event that just took place in Brussels, bringing together industry leaders and policymakers alike.

Net0Manager's Final Event

The Net0Manager consortium recently came together for its final project meeting, held as part of European Entrepreneurs CEA-PME's SME2B Business Forum Europe 2025, focused on "Net Zero in 2050... and how to get there". This marked an important milestone in the journey toward supporting SMEs in achieving Net Zero.

The Business Forum brought together industry leaders and policymakers from across Europe and proved to be highly productive. The agenda featured speakers from the European Commission, the business community, academia, and even African entrepreneurs, all sharing insights on how to achieve net-zero goals. Entrepreneurs presented their effective strategies, with one highlighting the benefits of taking the Net0Manager training, which helped optimize their operations and improve their services to clients.

Net0Manager's project coordinator, Kylene de Angelis, took the stage to present the project in its entirety, answering questions from the audience about micro-credentials and project results.

With this event concluded, Net0Manager is one step closer to the official end of its journey. Yet, its legacy will continue, as the consortium has been working relentlessly to ensure the project's impact and longevity far beyond its formal conclusion.



Net0Manager Policy Recommendations

The Net0Manager consortium has released its final Policy Paper, exploring how Europe's VET and adult learning systems can better respond to the urgent demand for sustainability competences in the green transition.

The study highlights the evolving role of Net0Managers and the potential of micro-credentials as flexible, credible tools to bridge skills gaps. It outlines seven key recommendations for policymakers, educators, and businesses such as:

- Establish a European-wide recognition framework for micro-credentials
- Co-design curricula with sectoral stakeholders
- Invest in capacity-building for educators and institutions

And more.

The message is clear: achieving Europe's net-zero ambitions will not be possible through technology alone, but through people equipped with the right skills.
